# Safety Audits

Over several seasons we have tried different approaches to conducting boat safety audits, of those boats that nominate to compete in Club races, and it would be fair to say that the result has been less than ideal in all cases. This is from the point of view of boat owners, and from the perspective of the auditors, the latter all being volunteers and doing this on their own time.

For the 2007/08 season we were proposing another approach. This was to require boat owners/skippers to conduct their own self-audit and to then obtain a sign-off from another boat owner/skipper in your own Division. The audit form, signed by both parties, was then to be held by the Club.

However, a check on our proposed system of "self-certification" for safety inspections, from firstly the YA and then Yachting NSW who passed me on to Bill Allen has changed our proposal. Bill, a retired gentleman who sails out of MHYC, is the guru for this topic in YNSW and runs the safety program for MHYC.

The short story-

Self-certification is not acceptable to YA/YNSW (tried previously and ruled out)

Audits must be by accredited inspectors. YNSW run courses for auditors; next one in June, then July, then August – we need to have some members attend. YNSW will run one for us at the Club if we can get about 10 starters. Are you interested, please contact the club!!!!!!!

No YA membership/no Club fees = no audit. No audit = no sail (race).

Saferty audits are also a significant requirement for our Aquatic Licence from Maritime NSW.

Bill says MHYC still sticks to a system of making appointments on a two-day weekend for audits prior to the season. The nub of it is that the procedure we proposed is not acceptable.

A secondary issue is that we don't have sufficient accredited auditors

We hope that all members will realise the significance of this and adopt an appropriate attitude to safety audits and have them completed prior to the sailing season at the times offered.

#### **Boat Insurance**

The Club requires all racing participants to have insurance to cover themselves and others in the event of an incident involving damage to boats or people. To date a review reveals that the records are not all up to date, and it is important, from the aspect of the Club's liability, that this be right. From the 2007/08 season onwards the individual insurance records will be maintained by the Club Safety Officer, who will hold the insurance records submitted by owners/skippers and who will ensure that all competing boats are covered. Boats not covered by insurance will not be permitted to race in GFS events. Please keep your insurance up to date!!
