#### **Facts Found**

1. Breeze was approximately from the NE and at around 7 knots.

- 2. A collision occurred between French Connection and Vitesse opposite the GFS Clubhouse close to the western shore of Onions Point.
- 3. French Connection was on starboard tack on a northerly heading.
- 4. In response to another yacht (unnamed) that had hailed "water", Vitesse found herself becalmed, close to the shore and in irons off Onions Point facing the GFS clubhouse.
- 5. At approximately 19:15hrs, French Connection and Vitesse converged.
- 6. French Connection from 5-10 metres away, hailed "starboard" three times.
- 7. Vitesse, whilst on a port tack, in response to the starboard hails replied that they had no steerage and we are unable to keep clear.
- 8. The lower portion of the bow of Vitesse had contact with the upper portside gunwale of French Connection.
- 9. The point of contact reveals that French Connection's was heeled substantially to port in order to make contact with Vitesse's bow just above the waterline.
- 10. When contact occurred, Vitesse had no steerage and was unable to avoid a pending collision, although the sails may have filled just prior to the collision.

#### Conclusion

- 1. French Connection did not avoid contact as required by Rule 14.
- 2. It was not reasonably possible for Vitesse to avoid the contact once it became clear that French Connection was not going to avoid contact.
