Sail Port Stephens – changed format.

The Commodores Cup series has been extended to five days of racing under PHS handicapping, while the Port Stephens Trophy will simultaneously be contested under the ORC Club rating system. Dates for the combined Sail Port Stephens 'Passage Series' will be **Monday 24 April** to **Saturday 29 April**, **2023**, with **Thursday 27 April** retained as a lay-day.

The Sail Port Stephens 'W/L Series' – which includes the NSW Yachting Championships sailed under IRC and ORCi – becomes a three-day, stand-alone event held from **5-7 May 2023**. Accompanying the fleet will be Act 3 of the TP52 Gold Cup, and a new trophy for ORC Club fleet, again utilising windward-leeward courses.

Finally, **19-21 May 2023** has been set aside for the Sail Port Stephens "Bay Series". This is exclusively for sports boats, trailer sailers, off-the-beach dinghies and Windsurfers, hosted by The Bay Sailing Centre at Salamander Bay.

A major social event will be held on the Wednesday night, as per usual, but with only daily prizes awarded.

GFS entries so far are – *Echo, Hasta La Vista, Passion X, Tana.*

West Harbour Winter Series, 2023

All boats from GFS fleets (Twilight and Saturday) with paid membership, Category 7 safety and current insurance with racing cover are eligible to enter the West Harbour Winter Series.

The ADR Presentation

The presentaion for the Australia Day Regatta was held at Sydney Town Hall on Tuesday March 28. The recipients of trophies and first place medallions were presented with their awards. Finger food and drinks were provided in an convivial atmosphere. Unfortunately, very few of the GFS first place recipients were in attendance. Disappointing, as GFS has participated in the regatta for several years and has the largest fleet competing in a satellite regatta (even more competitors than in the harbour event on Australia Day).



The Lane Cove River

The Aboriginal name for the Lane Cove River is Turrumburra.

Governor Phillip was the first European to lead an expedition into the Lane Cove River Valley, some three months after the arrival of the First Fleet. Lieutenant Ralph Clark, accompanied by three convicts, explored the Lane Cove River Valley in 1790. They rowed some 10 kilometres up the Lane Cove River and recorded that they saw Aboriginal people.

The river near Fullers Bridge is the site of the mysterious deaths of Dr Gilbert Bogle and Margaret Chandler on January 1, 1963. The case became famous because the cause of death could not be established and because it exposed the libertarian activities of a group of left-wing intellectuals known as the 'Sydney Push'.

The bodies were found in unusual circumstances. Bogle was partly covered by a carpet square while Chandler's body was covered by cardboard. Both had their clothing laid neatly over them. Conspiracy theories abounded at the time and poisoning of some kind seemed to be the cause of death.

In 2016 a new theory emerged that in the early hours of the morning an eruption of hydrogen sulphide gas from the polluted river caused potentially lethal fumes to pool in deadly quantities at the location where the bodies were eventually found. The explanation for the strange covering of the bodies was that a passer-by, not a murderer, covered Bogle and Chandler to preserve their modesty.
