For contact with the club, starter and competing yachts we will be using VHF 73 (This will replace VHF 72).

Club Pontoon

Recently there have been several instances where boats have tied up at the club pontoon on race days, especially Sunday when dinghies are rigging and preparing to leave the club.

Please be aware that the GFS House Rules state -

'Any boat which is not racing should not moor at the pontoon for the purpose of carrying out repairs or maintenance for 2 hours prior to a yacht race. In respect of dinghy sailing on Sundays, dinghies being launched or recovered have priority use of the pontoon. Boats should not moor during the time from the launch of the Sabots to the completion of their racing and return to the rigging deck'.
